Reproductive justice is the complete physical, mental, spiritual, political, social, and economic well-being of women and girls, based on the full achievement and protection of women's human rights. Mirroring the work of SisterSong, this Indivisible group will use anti-violent frameworks to examine the ways structural issues like choice, affordable abortion access, family planning, transitional care, and bodily autonomy are affected by race, class, immigration status, gender identity, sexuality, and ability. Through research, meetings, and collaboration with a variety of local and national organizations such as Planned Parenthood, Center for Reproductive Rights, Anti Violence Project, Sylvia Rivera Law Project, UltraViolet, RAINN, SeaChange, NARAL, Black Lives Matter, Callen-Lourde Center, and National Latina Institute of Reproductive Health, we will implement strategic actions and agenda items to disrupt oppressive tactics that limit and distort women's access to physical, reproductive, and behavioral health care.
